- ▶ **Operation hours** | 09:30-18:40 (No service on Mondays, New Year's Day and Chuseok Holiday)
- ▶ **Starting point** | Daegu City Tour bus stop in front of Dongdaegu Train Station. (Boarding is possible at every City Tour bus stop)
- ▶ **Tickets** | Passengers can purchase tickets on the City Tour bus (cash, credit card, transportation card)
- ▶ **Fees** | Adults: 5,000 won, middle & high school students : 4,000 won children-senior citizens +the disabled-patriots and veterans: 3,000 won
 - ※ A passenger accompanying a severely disabled person (1st-3rd degree disability): 3,000 won kids under 48 months: free
 - ※ 20% fare discount
 - Passengers with a train or express bus ticket for the same day

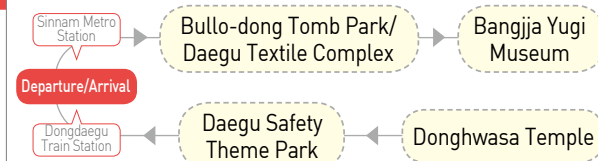

(Tuesday through Sunday, Closed on Mondays, 09:30~17:00)

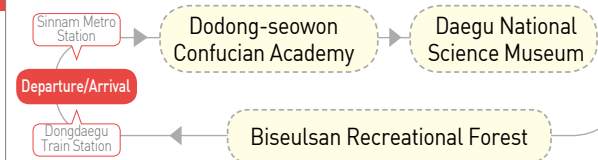


TIP

(Tuesday-Friday / 09:30~17:00)



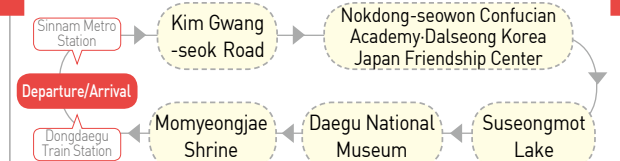
TIP

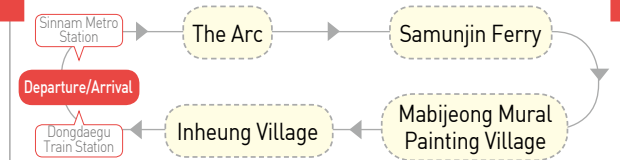

Speed boat ride is available for taking a quick tour of beautiful scenery around Nakdong River area, Gangeong Goryeong Weir, etc.

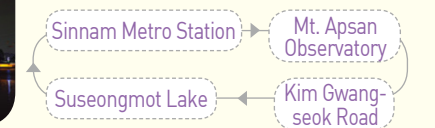

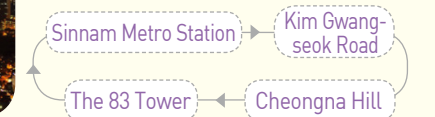

01 Dongdaegu Train Station



Dongdaegu Train Station is a transportation hub where KTX high-speed trains and express buses are available. Tourists can enjoy fantastic Daegu tour on a Daegu City Tour Bus. The bus stop is in front of Dongdaegu Train Station. Tickets can be purchased on the bus.

03 Dongseongno



Dongseongno is the busiest street of the downtown Daegu. Lined up along the street are trend-leading shopping malls, department stores, as well as various cultural spaces like movie theaters and performance halls. Famous alleys such as Yasi-golmok Alley, Rodeo Street and Cosmetics Street are also located.

04 Gyeongsang-gamyeong Park & Jongno



The park area includes an over 400-year old site of Gyeongsang Provincial Governor's Office during the Joseon Dynasty. There still remain Seonhwadang hall, Jingcheonggak pavilion and Seonjeongbi monument. Nearby is Jongno Street, where traces of Korean modern history remain and the Yangnyeongsi Oriental Herb Medicine Market.

05 Modern Culture Alley



Cheongna Hill is a center for Daegu's Christianity, which had taken root, settled and grown in Daegu. The residence for the Christian missionary 100 years ago still stands. It was remodeled to serve as a museum of medical and missionary works. (The starting point of Alley Tour Course 2)

06 Seomun Market & Dalseong Park



Seomun Market, one of the "big 3" markets of the Joseon Dynasty era, is huge to sell almost everything one could wish to find, including fabrics, the main products in the market. Dalseong Park is located inside the oldest earthen mound fortress in the Korean fortification history, dating from 261 A.D.

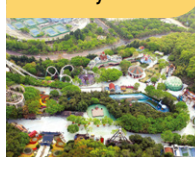
07 Bangogae Muchimhoe Alley

13 Kim Gwang-seok Road



It is a beautiful street of art and culture, which is filled with the wall paintings and song lyrics of a singer, late Kim Gwang-seok. 14 Gukchae-bosang Memorial Park



Gukchae-bosang Memorial Park was built to commemorate the Gukchaebosang National Debt Repayment Movement which began in Daegu in 1907. The park has the Dalgubeol Grand Bell, Gukchae-bosang Memorial Hall and a path with monuments inscribed with famous quotes. Walking along the path of the giant oak trees is also recommended.
