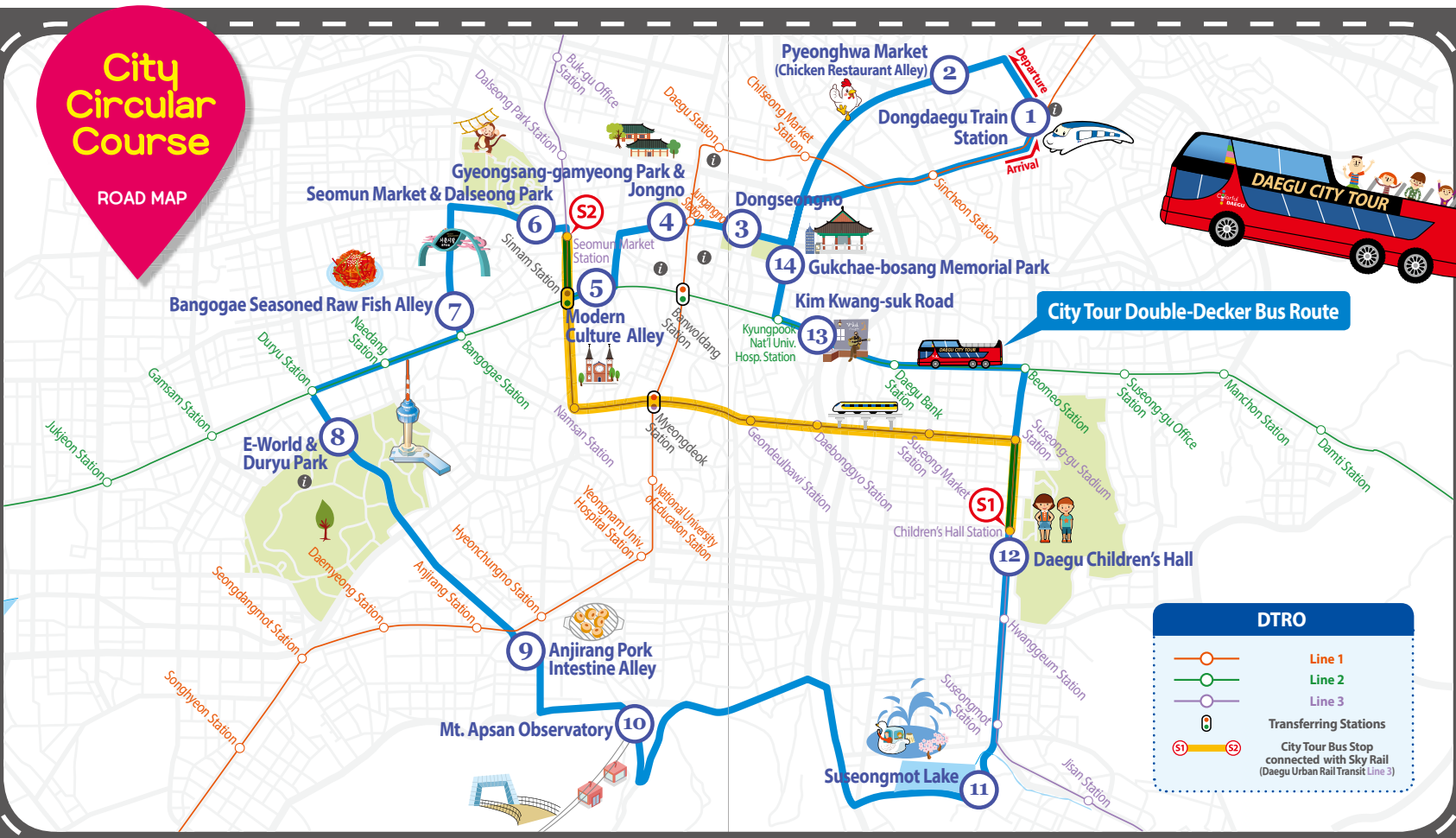


## City Tour Double-Decker Bus Service Guide

- ▶ **Hours:** 09:30~18:40(No service on Mondays, New Year's Day and Chuseok Holiday)
- ▶ **Starting point:** Daegu City Tour Bus Stop in front of Dongdaegu Train Station  
(Embarkation and disembarkation is possible from every stop)
- ▶ **Purchasing tickets:** Tickets can be purchased on the city tour bus.(Cash, credit cards and transportation cards are accepted)
- ▶ **Fees:** 5,000won for adults, 4,000won for middle & high school students, 3,000won for children, senior citizens, the disabled & men of national merit
  - ※3,000won for one person who accompanies the severely disabled(1st~3rd degree disability).
  - Free for one child under 48 months, accompanied by an adult
  - ※20% fare discount for
    - Passengers who have purchased a train or express bus ticket, or who possess an urban rail transit receipt valid for the same day of the tour
    - Foreign tourists(with voucher from hotels, guest houses, and Hanok traditional houses)
    - Passengers in groups of over 10 persons
- ▶ **Benefits:**
  - ① Free embarkation and disembarkation possible from every stop, all day with a one time ticket purchase
  - ② Various discount benefits are offered from tourist attractions when the ticket holder presents their city tour bus ticket for the day of the tour.(Please refer to pages 30 & 31).
  - ③ Guide service is offered on the bus, presented by an official Culture & Tour Guide.
  - ④ Discounted tickets for the Daegu Urban Rail Transit can be purchased(on the city tour bus)

(Chicken Restaurant Alley)**

The speciality of Pyeonghwa Market is most definitely "Chicken Restaurant Alley". There is no citizen of Daegu who doesn't already know this famous chicken restaurant alley, although it is better known as "Chicken Gizzard Alley". Living up to its name, the origin of Chicken Restaurant Alley began with the procurement of chicken gizzard dishes, which were first served as an accompaniment to alcoholic beverages in the market in the 1970s. Various chicken dishes including fried chicken gizzards with a chewy texture are served presently at reasonable prices. Thus, this area is frequented by many visitors.

**Ayang Gichtgil(Railroad Bridge)** (1) 20 minute walk

Ayang Gichtgil is a closed railroad bridge, which has been transformed into a cultural space. This old railroad has been redecorated with a modern touch, including an observatory platform, a cafe, a bridge museum and a meditation place. Dongchon Resort can be viewed in the distance, however it is the beautiful night view from the site that attracts many people.

**National Daegu Meteorological Science Museum** (1) Approx. 2.8km distance

A great place for field learning, this museum provides easy understanding and experience in meteorology and climate, as well as a look back at the meteorological history of Korea at a glance.

## Dongseongno

※ Dongseongno Festival: held every May

Dongseongno has become the representative symbol of Daegu, such that when you think of Daegu, it surfaces foremost in your mind. This busy street is full of the lively spirit of youth throughout the year. It has also been the center of politics, economy and culture of Daegu, since the Gyeongsang-gameyeong(Gyeongsang Provincial Governor's Office) had moved to the city in 1601. Lined up along the street are various spaces for shopping, culture and dining, featuring various shopping malls, department stores, movie theaters, performances halls, fancy restaurants, bars and singing rooms, among other delights.

# Gyeongsang-gamyong Park & Jongno

※ Departing Point for Daegu Modern Culture Alley Tour Course 1

Gyeongsang-gamyong Park contains the site where the Gyeongsang Provincial Governor's Office was first located, when it was moved to Daegu from Andong in 1601(34th reign of King Seonjo). Seonhwadang hall still remains at this picturesque site, which served as the governor's office. Jingcheonggak pavilion, which was the governors' residence, and Seonjeongbi monuments, which explain the governors' achievements also still stand in the park. On the west side of the park, is Jongno, a street which originally ran north to south through the center of Daegu Eupseong Fortress reaching its Southern Gate. Nearby is Yangnyeongsi Oriental Herb Medicine Market.

## Modern Culture Alley

※ Departing Point for Daegu Modern Culture Alley Tour Course 2

Cheongna Hill is a center where Christianity had taken root and settled in a local community in Daegu. The present Dongsan Medical Center has expanded in Daegu by serving society through medical activities. The residences for the Christian missionary of 100 years ago still stand on the hill, and have been converted into a museum of medical and missionary works, education and history, where a variety of items of historical value are on display.

**March 1st Independence Movement Road  
(3 minute walk)**

The March 1st Independence Movement Road was used by students who joined the anti-Japanese movement spun from the March 1st Independence Movement in 1919, in order to avoid the surveillance of Japanese soldiers. It is also called '90 Stairs Road'.



**Gyesan Cathedral (4 minute walk)**

It is the first Gothic style cathedral in the Southern Yeongnam region and was designated as Historical Site No.290. With recent exterior lighting installed, a beautiful night view of the church is presented.

Seomun Market was one of the "big 3" markets of the Joseon Dynasty era, and is the biggest traditional market south of Han River. This market is divided into 6 districts mostly dealing with textile goods such as draperies, fabrics and clothing. It is big enough to sell almost everything one could wish to find, ranging from fruits, dried fish, and seafood to shoes. Dalseong was the name of an earthen mound fortress once used as a strategic military point, and a stronghold of "Dalgubeol", the tribal state of ancient Daegu. In the park, there is a zoo, the Local History Hall, the Gwanpungnu Pavilion and the Stele of Poet Lee Sang-hwa.

The Alley originated around 1947 when people collected waste tools outflow from US Army Bases and sold them. Boosted by the development of the machine industry in later years, the alley was firmly established.

**Site of Samsung Trading Company (8 minute walk)**

The Site of Samsung Trading Company is the place where the late Lee Byung-chul, founder of the Samsung Group founded the Samsung Trading Company (called Samsung-sanghoe) in 1938. It embodies the starting ground for the present Samsung Group, which has grown to be one of the world's leading enterprises.

**Daegu Art Factory (13 minute walk)**

Once a tobacco factory, one of the city's industrial legacies from a former downtown core area, this structure was remodeled and converted into an art-creating and display space.
